Preliminary Design Plans Drawn Up for Prefectural Government Buildings

We are working towards the realization of redevelopment plans for the prefectural government buildings (drawn up March 2016). Having taken on board suggestions from residents received at our explanatory meeting and through our call for suggestions, we have published our preliminary design plans.

Notice Business Owners, Please Pay Your Employees' Individual Inhabitants' Taxes By Special Collection

The special collection of individual inhabitants' tax is a system whereby business owners deduct individual inhabitants' taxes from their employees' monthly salary in the same way as income tax. Business owners have the responsibility to pay their employees' individual inhabitants' taxes by special collection.

<Features of Special Collection>

- Business owners do not need to calculate taxes or make year-end adjustments
- Employees do not need to go to the bank and do not risk forgetting to pay their taxes

Alert What to Do in the Event of a Ballistic Missile Launch

Ballistic missiles may land around 10 minutes after being launched. If you receive information that a missile has been launched from the J-Alert or area mail warning systems, please remain calm and take the following action as appropriate.

<If outdoors>

Shelter underground or inside a nearby building.

<If there are no buildings nearby>

Take cover within shade and protect your head

<If indoors>

Stay away from windows, or move to a room with no windows
